ELM SEEDS: If you do manage to find some elm seeds and they are beginning to dry out and turn light brown. You could start your very own little tree nursery! Pick a few and pop the individual disc shaped seeds in small plant pots with some soil, give them a water and leave them in a safe spot outdoors for the rest of the year. These should easily grow into baby elm trees for you to plant in the future.
